Item No 1:

The changes in the NEP curriculum structure and those in the BoS composition, as suggested and approved by the respective BoS (if any), were presented.


Hon. AC discussed and approved the changes in the NEP curriculum structure as approved by the respective BoS and changes in the composition of BoS, as applicable.

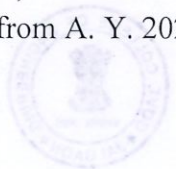


To discuss and finalize the proposed syllabi of the courses to be offered for Third Year of the B. Tech. programs as per NEP curriculum structure, for all programs in the following order (to be presented by the respective member-secretary, BoS) to be implemented with effect from A. Y. 2025-26.

- i. Mechanical Engineering
- ii. Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering
- iii. Instrumentation Engineering
- iv. Electrical Engineering
- v. Computer Engineering
- vi. Civil Engineering
- vii. Science and Humanities

The proposed syllabi of the courses to be offered for Third Year of the B. Tech. programs as per NEP curriculum structure, for all 6 UG programs as approved by the respective BoS (to be implemented with effect from A. Y. 2025-26) was presented in the meeting.







Hon. AC discussed and approved the revised syllabi of Third Year B. Tech. courses of all the 6 B. Tech. programs, revised syllabi of the F. Y. B. Tech. courses ET151N Basic Electronics Engineering, ET152N Basic Electronics Engineering Laboratory and revised syllabi of additional open elective courses offered by Department of Science and Humanities for T. Y. B. Tech. students.

Item No 5

To discuss and approve the following points regarding NPTEL MOOC courses:

- i. Marks allocation and final Grading slabs for NPTEL courses need to be finalized. Accordingly, rules need to be added to the autonomy rule for grading of NPTEL courses.
- ii. Teaching assignment hours to be considered for mentor faculty assigned for NPTEL/MOOC course/s
- iii. Approval to the policy of reimbursement of NPTEL examination fee and local conveyance for students and faculty after successful completion of the NPTEL course.

The points related to NPTEL MOOC courses were explained in the meeting elaborately by Prof. Shirish Adam, SPOC of NPTEL local chapter, Govt. CoE, Jalgaon.

- i. Marks allocation and final Grading slabs for NPTEL courses need to be finalized. Accordingly, rules need to be added to the autonomy rule for grading of NPTEL courses.

After discussion, it has been resolved in the meeting that, for the credit transfer case, 15 marks will be added to the actual marks secured by the student who passes the NPTEL course with certificate type 'Successfully completed / Elite / Elite+Silver / Elite+Gold'. In case of no certification/FAIL in NPTEL examination, student will be eligible to appear for the next institute examination of equivalent course. In such a case, to pass the same course in the institute examination, the student needs to score 24 marks [40%] out of 60 in the Theory-ESE examination of equivalent course and the marks secured out of 60 will be converted to out of 100.

- ii. Teaching assignment hours to be considered for mentor faculty assigned for NPTEL/MOOC course/s

As mentor faculty has to engage with students and the average effort required by concerned mentor faculty is 4 hours/week, it has been resolved in the meeting that an equivalent teaching assignment of 2 hours/week will be considered for the mentor faculty, provided the minimum number of students enrolled for that NPTEL course is 10.

- iii. Approval to the policy of reimbursement of NPTEL examination fee and local conveyance for students and faculty after successful completion of the NPTEL course.

As per current institute policy finalized during TEQIP program, NPTEL examination registration fee and local conveyance to appear at an examination centre, is fully reimbursed to the students [irrespective of the concerned NPTEL course is enrolled in-lieu of GCOEJ curriculum for credit


