**Item No 1:**

To read and confirm the minutes of seventeenth (17<sup>th</sup>) meeting of Academic Council held on 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2024.

The minutes of 17<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council held on 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2024 were presented. Hon. AC noted and approved the MoM of 17<sup>th</sup> meeting of AC.

**Item No. 2:**

To note the action taken report based on the MoM of 17<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council.

The action taken report (ATR) based on the MoM of 17<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council was presented. Hon. AC noted and approved the ATR.

**Item No. 3:**

To decide about the proposal for carry-on (as per Maharashtra State GR - शासन आदेश क्र. संकीर्ण-२०२५/ई-१७०२२०/विशि-३ दि. १० फेब्रुवारी, २०२५) based on the results of Winter-2024 examination instead of Summer-2024 examination.

Govt. of Maharashtra has released a GR regarding carry-on for Engineering Students for the AY 2024-25. As stated in the GR, the eligibility conditions for promotion to higher classes remain the same; but these eligibility conditions for promotion to higher class will be applied on the basis of result of Winter-2024 examination instead of Summer-2024 examination. Hon. AC discussed and approved the proposal of carry-on for the AY 2024-25 only, as per the conditions stated above and as per GR.

**Item No 4**

To decide about the proposal to grant an extension of one academic year to an applicant for completion of the degree program on medical ground as a special case.

As per autonomy rules of the institute, the maximum duration allowed to complete the degree program is 7 years (for FY admitted students). Ms. Supriya Sudarshanrao Wakde PRN 1822230 (Branch: Instrumentation) has already completed 7 years after admission in AY 2023-24 and still has backlog of 5 courses. She had applied for extension of one more year for the completion of the degree program on medical ground. Hon. AC discussed the case and granted extension of one academic year for completion of the degree program.

The proposal of the B. Tech. degree program in this institute under NEP to be recognized as '**Apprenticeship Embedded Degree Program**' (AEDP) as per AICTE guidelines for AEDP, was presented in the meeting. Member Secretary-AC Dr. S. P. Mohani and Chairperson Dr. S. S. Gajre briefed the members about AEDP. The prime requirement for AEDP viz. the professional internship / On-Job-Training (OJT) component of 6 months duration is already incorporated in the NEP curriculum of the institute. This AEDP recognition will facilitate in getting internship opportunities to the students with or without stipend under various AICTE schemes as well as under the Board of Apprenticeship Training (BoAT). The AC was informed about the MoU inked with BoAT - Western Region in this regard.

Hon. AC provided the approval to the proposal of the B. Tech. degree program in this institute under NEP to be recognized as '**Apprenticeship Embedded Degree Program**' (AEDP) as per AICTE guidelines for AEDP.

To provide post-facto approval to the 'Internal Performance Cancellation' (IPC) rule (implemented with effect from Re-examination Summer-2024)

Member-secretary-AC informed the AC members that after cancelling the provision for Re-MSE, the provision of 'Internal Performance Cancellation' (IPC) was re-introduced with effect from Re-examination Summer-2024, as per decision in the meeting of Academic Program Evaluation Committee (APEC) and approval of Hon. Principal, in view of emergent need. Student after failing in any course has the option to cancel the internal performance (MSE and ISA) of that course before appearing for the re-examination of that course and in such a case student has to secure minimum 40% marks in the ESE of that course.

Hon. AC provided post-facto approval to the 'Internal Performance Cancellation' (IPC) rule (implemented with effect from Re-examination Summer-2024).


